

Daytime School Party Policies

SCHOOL PARTY TIMING

School parties are for 2 hours, and are extended by 30 minutes if Pizza Buffet option is chosen.

- *Before exiting the bus* – a staff member will give instructions for the party about skates, gum chewing, etc.
- *First 15 min* – Get on skates, play arcade, shoes in baskets.
- *30 min after party start* – Snack bar opens, skate counter closes
- *Start of 2nd hour* – Begin single FREE Drink distribution by classroom/age (no free refills); students choose from soda options (including Dr. Pepper), water, or pink lemonade. Pizza Buffet or pizza slice option would begin at this time.
- *30 minutes prior to party end* – Snack bar closes, games shut off to facilitate ticket redemption at stuff shop, skate counter reopens to collect skates, Pizza Buffet ends.
- *15 min prior to party end* – DJ plays special game, if needed, to aid students in orderly skate return; stuff shop attendants assist as many as possible on last minute purchases/redemptions.
- *5 min prior to party end* – Students ready to line up for count and return to transportation.

Scheduling Issue

If a scheduling issue arises, please contact us as soon as possible. We may be able to move you to an alternate date. Dates fill up quickly as many schools book 6 months to a year in advance.

Daytime School Party Payment

Payment of your party is due by the end of your party time. We do not customarily do purchase orders. No sales tax is added to a school party. We accept cash or major credit cards or a school check in payment. Personal checks and American Express are not accepted.

Complimentary Skate Mates

We have more than 15 skate mates to help children learn to skate. As a bonus, skate mates are included at no charge for school and daycare private events. During public session or private party rentals, skate mates cost \$3 per hour rental.

We ask that the chaperons monitor the use of skate mates and encourage sharing so that everyone who needs one will have a chance to use it for some part of the skating party.

School Party Count

All students, whether skating or not, are included in the party count, unless injured. You have one FREE adult skater/chaperone included for every 10 students. Students LOVE when their teachers skate and play laser tag with them!

Parents who would like to skate with their children are welcome to pay a discount rate of \$6 to receive a skate ticket and small drink.

Free Drink

Only ONE free small 12 oz drink is included in the school party pricing, unless the pizza buffet is chosen. Refills are \$1.50 for any size drink.

Pizza Buffet

We make awesome pizza! We serve pepperoni, cheese, and sausage pizzas. The buffet begins one hour after the party starts and lasts for one hour. Each person receives an initial two slices of pizza with their first drink. After all have been served, guests are welcome to come up for additional pizza and drink refills during the pizza buffet hour.

Adults with the group that are not skating are charged \$4.50 for buffet plus \$2 for a large drink.

Outside Food Daytime Party

No outside food, drink, sack lunches, snacks, etc. may be brought into the facility. We offer a variety of food and snack options that may be added during the reservation process.

Music

Age appropriate, Mom-approved music is played during daytime hours in our facility. **After 7pm**, a wider range of music and videos that may not be deemed appropriate for children under 12 will be offered to cater to teens and adults. Please keep this in mind when selecting a party time.

Playground Area & Rules

The three-story indoor Playsmart Playground is available to children 10 & under for a flat fee of \$40 for the whole group or individuals may purchase a playground wristband for \$3 each. A wristband is required to play. Playground admission is \$2 per guest with a minimum of 10. This is a \$1 discount per child from the regular playground rate.

If a child misbehaves, they may be asked to leave the playground for a period of time (timeout). After returning, if the bad behavior continues, they may be banned from the playground for that day. This is at the staff's discretion. While this does not often happen, it is a necessary rule for the enjoyment and safety of all the children in the playground. No refund will be issued.

No shoes or skates may be worn inside the playground. Shelving is provided to store shoes while playing. For sanitary reasons, all children must wear socks in the playground area. Socks are available for \$2 per pair at the front office.

Parents should enter the playground only if a child needs assistance.
